

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Beaumont Hospital. We wish to outline the medical training programme in Beaumont Hospital for Non Consultant Hospital Doctors. As you can see there are a large number of lectures, research symposia, clinical conferences and tutorials. The purpose behind these are to ensure that, in addition to your training on the individual medical services, you have the opportunity also to be exposed to the broad spectrum of medical education which is readily available in Beaumont Hospital. Weekly Grand Rounds are held every Tuesday morning from September to the end of May at 8am in the Robert Adams Lecture Theatre. These involve comprehensive presentations of common medical problems.

For NCHD's undertaking the Membership, specific membership orientated tutorials are scheduled weekly in a syllabus format with one topic speciality covered. At the end of this series of lectures, a weekend revision course for Part I "The Beaumont Hospital Revision Course" given by experienced Medical Consultant staff is held in November and March each year. Weekend revision for the Part II Written course for Part II Written given by Prof. R. Costello is held in April, June and November each year. A weekend revision course for part II clinical exam is held twice a year usually June and October.

For NCHD's undertaking the MRCS exams there are tutorials twice weekly given by Surgical Consultants.

A non-invasive Ventilation Workshop is organised by Prof. R. Costello and Sr. Deirdre Long. All Registrars and SHO's are welcome to register for this workshop. A workshop will be held for all Interns on their weekly Wednesday Tutorials.
